Jason will demonstrate a wide variety of print techniques for potters. He will explain the process from the idea, covering each stage of the creative process. Participants will discover traditional and non-traditional methods introduced in a variety of combinations. With a focus on screen-printed, Making screens, ordering screens ready to go, printing processes and decal manipulation Jason will approach both hand-built and wheel thrown examples. Come explore numerous illustrative techniques through surface and form through varying techniques.

Jason graduated from Western Kentucky University with a BFA in ceramics and BA's in both printmaking and graphic design. He continued his education as a core fellowship student at Penland School of Crafts in western North Carolina. Since then he has exhibited nationally, been featured in *Ceramics Monthly*, *American Craft Magazine*. Jason's work is featured in *500 Prints on Clay* (Lark Books) and he's the author of *Graphic Clay: Ceramic Surfaces and Printed Image Transfer Techniques* (Lark Books, 2015).

Burnett lives in Louisville, Kentucky where he lives and works. He teaches extensively throughout the United States each year.
